Surface Mining Permit Transfer

Mr. James Matheny of the Office of Geology advised the Permit Board that the surface mining permit transfer regarding the Joe McGee Construction Co., Inc. matter was withdrawn from the agenda due to lack of material from the applicant.

POLLUTION CONTROL MATTERS:
Solid Waste Management & Mining**

Northeast MS Regional Landfill:

On motion by Pat Phillips and seconded by Jim Lipe, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendations to issue the following permits:

Sandra Taylor of the Environmental Permits Division presented information regarding the renewal and modification of several permits for the Northeast Mississippi Regional Landfill. A public hearing was held on February 5, 2015, regarding the reissuance and modification to wastewater pretreatment permit MSP091079, to allow the permittee to discharge of 30,000 gallons per day of landfill leachate to the Corinth POTW instead of Booneville POTW.

Ms. Taylor asked the Board to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the renewal of Stormwater NPDES Permit MSS049301 and the renewal of Title V Air Permit 2660-00055. Ms. Taylor advised the Board that EPA had the opportunity to review all applications, comments and staff recommendations. Staff reviewed all applications and determined that they complied with the solid waste regulations.

Construction Building Material Branch

Mr. Michael Griffin of the Environmental Permits Division announced to the Permit Board that on March 2, 2015, the Environmental Permits Division's staff reissued the State Wide Multimedia Hot Mix Asphalt Facility General Permit.

MMC Materials, Inc.

Mr. Griffin advised the Board of a request for a major modification for Ready Mix Concrete General Permit Coverage, MSG110026. MMC Materials, Inc. proposed to replace its existing 120 cubic yard per hour concrete plant with a new 150 cubic yard per hour plant at its existing facility in Forest, Scott County, Mississippi. MMC submitted a major modification form for its coverage under the Ready Mix Concrete General Permit. Mr. Griffin stated that the major modification form submitted by MMC was technically complete and advised the Board that the Ready Mix facility will be considered a minor source of air emissions. As required, the applicant notified the contiguous land owners via certified mail/ return receipt requested, of the proposed modification of the facility. MDEQ's Environmental

Permits Division received one letter from a landowner objecting to the proposed modification. MDEQ Staff replied to the objecting landowner on March 4, 2015, to address his concerns. Staff advised the Permit Board that MMC was currently in compliance with the Ready Mix Concrete General Permit and up to date on all requirements. Staff recommended the modification be issued. Mark McCormick with MMC Materials, Inc. was present in support of the permit and to answer any questions.

On motion by Jim Lipe and seconded by Pat Phillips, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the modification of Ready Mix Concrete General Permit MSG110026.

Alliance Consulting Group, LLC, Picayune Frac Plant; Transfer of Permits to Dry Facility Asset Holding, LLC and Modification of the Section 401 Water Quality Certification, Pearl River County, Mississippi

Dry Facility Asset Holding, Inc. ("DFAH") applied for transfer of permits and modification of a Section 401 Water Quality Certification previously issued to Alliance Consulting Group, LLC ("Alliance). Specifically, DFAH requested transfer of the Certificate of Coverage under Mississippi's Large Construction Storm Water General Permit (MSR106120); Certificate of Coverage under Mississippi's Baseline Storm Water General Permit (MSR002071); and an Individual Permit to Construct Air Emissions equipment (2180-00052). Additionally, DFAH applied for a modification of the Section 401 Water Quality Certification that was issued to ACG by the Permit Board on May 14, 2013, to reflect its ownership of the facility and to include a revised mitigation plan.

The former Alliance facility is located at 130 Street B in Picayune, Pearl River County, Mississippi. The facility processes sand for use in hydro-fracking related activities. DFAH became the new owner of the facility after a bankruptcy sale of the facility's assets.

Mr. Harry Wilson, Chief of MDEQ's Environmental Permits Division, advised the Permit Board that the Ravenwood Homeowners Association had previously requested an evidentiary hearing after the Permit Board issued the Section 401 Water Quality Certification to Alliance in May 2013. After the hearing was scheduled, Alliance petitioned the Permit Board for a continuance because Alliance was undergoing corporate restructuring issues and believed the majority ownership of the facility would change. Shortly after the Permit Board granted the continuance, Alliance was forced into an involuntary bankruptcy. The bankruptcy court approved the sale of the Alliance facility to DFAH. Mr. Wilson reminded the Board that the evidentiary hearing was still pending regarding the Board's initial decision to issue the 401 certification to Alliance and would go forward should the Permit Board modify the certification to reflect the new ownership and to include the revised mitigation plan. Ms. Florance Bass, Director of MDEQ's Water Quality Certification Division, Mr. Steve Bailey, with MDEQ's Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Division, Mr. Roy Furrh, MDEQ's General Counsel, and Ms. Lisa Ouzts, MDEQ Senior Attorney, were all on hand to answer questions the Permit Board had regarding compliance and other issues at the facility.

Mr. Skip Negrotto, attorney for the Ravenwood Homeowners Association, was allowed to address the Permit Board. Mr. Negrotto advised the Board that Ravenwood opposed the transfer and modification request for several reasons including odors, turbidity of Alligator Branch, and accumulation of sand on the residents' patios all of which they claimed were associated with operation of the plant. Mr. Negrotto urged the Permit Board to hold the evidentiary hearing on the water quality certification issued to Alliance before deciding whether to transfer the permits and modify the certification to reflect the new ownership of the facility. Ms. Donna Hodges, MDEQ Senior Attorney who sat with the Permit Board, advised the Board that according to information on the Mississippi Secretary of

State's website, Alliance had dissolved and had ceased to exist as a corporate entity in Mississippi. Thus, if the Board went forward with the hearing on the water quality certification, it would be doing so with the certification being issued to a company that no longer exists.

Armanda Tollison, DFAH's attorney, also addressed the Permit Board. Ms. Tollison urged the Permit Board to transfer the permits to the correct entity, the new owner of the plant. Ms. Tollison also addressed the odor, turbidity, and sand complaints made by the Ravenwood residents. Ms. Tollison specifically informed the Board that the facility is located in an industrial park with two plastic plants, a creosote plant, and a plant that manufactures mercaptan, which is added to natural gas to give it a distinct odor. Ms. Tollison explained the corporate issues, the bankruptcy, and stated that DFAH was ready to go forward with an evidentiary hearing on the water quality certification; DFAH just wanted to make sure the proper party was before the Board.

Staff recommended that the Permit Board transfer the coverages and air permit to DFAH and further recommended the Board modify the water quality certification to reflect the new site ownership and to include the updated mitigation plan. On motion by Dennis Riecke and seconded by Pat Phillips, the Permit Board voted unanimously to accept Staff's recommendation.

Agriculture Branch

The Steve Nguyen Poultry matter was resolved at staff level and withdrawn from the agenda.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Roy Furth advised the Permit Board that the notice that was posted on MDEQ's website regarding the Permit Board meeting being moved to the third Tuesday in March will be included as part of the March minutes.

MEETING ADJOURNED

There being no further business to come before the Permit Board, Leslie Royals adjourned the meeting.
