MEETINGS & SCHEDULE

The Panel may meet up to four (4) times a year. Quarterly meetings are usually held at the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality office in Jackson. However, the Panel can elect to have meetings in a different location and/or on a different date. Following our customary planning of past meetings, the 2017 CAP meetings will tentatively be held on:

- **Thursday, January 26, 2017**
- **Thursday, April 27, 2017**
- **Thursday, July 27, 2017**
- **Thursday, October 26, 2017**

These dates may be modified based on the availability of Panel members to attend.

At the first meeting of 2017, the CAP members will need to nominate/vote on a chairperson. The acting chair will be able to navigate the Panel through this process. The Chairperson of the Mississippi Small Business Compliance Advisory Panel or a designated alternate representative will also serve as a member of Title V Advisory Council. The Title V Advisory Council, along with the MDEQ Air Division, evaluates the annual revenue needed to conduct Mississippi's Title V program. The SBEAP is a component of the Title V program, and the CAP member who serves on the Title V Advisory Council is the voice for MS small businesses.
