**Available Solid Waste Management Facilities in
Tornado Impacted Counties
(Attala, Holmes, Yazoo, and surrounding counties)
April 30, 2017**

This information has been prepared by MDEQ to assist in responding to the damage needs from recent tornado events in south Mississippi. There are several existing solid waste management facilities in these areas that should be available for disposal of debris subject to the operating conditions of the facility, the type of debris to be disposed, and the approval of the site operator. Additionally, MDEQ encourages interested persons to contact local officials to find out if other local waste collection points, such as transfer stations, are available for use by the public.

The solid waste facilities identified on the attached listings can accept certain approved solid waste materials as follows:

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfills: The MSW landfill sites are approved to accept all household garbage, mixed building debris, vegetative debris, commercial wastes, office wastes, packaging wastes and any other nonhazardous solid waste.

Class I Rubbish Sites: Class I rubbish sites are approved to accept all rubbish wastes and building and structural debris such as brick, wood, metal, concrete, roofing, siding, furniture, carpet and other types of building debris. The sites can also accept all class II rubbish such as vegetative wastes and inert debris. The sites cannot accept household garbage, household chemicals, containers, or certain industrial wastes for disposal.

Class II Rubbish Sites: Class II rubbish sites are approved to accept vegetative wastes and inert debris such as concrete and brick that can be separated from other building debris. The sites cannot accept mixed building debris, household garbage or household chemicals.

MDEQ may also be working with the local government to evaluate and approve temporary storm debris management sites in affected counties that are not included on the attached listing of permanent permitted solid waste facilities. Additional information on these sites will be provided as it is made available.
